### 2. Site-Specific Hazards

Proximity to industrial estate	Potential for hazardous material release, noise, or fire	Low	High	Regular liaison with estate management; emergency response planning

Mearby road	Risk of traffic accidents or air pollution	Medium	Medium	Secure site fencing
Nearby train line	Risk of electrocution, serious impact injury or death	Medium	High	Secure site fencing; liaison with South West Trains; student education

Violent intrusion	Malicious entry, arson, or explosive device	Low	Very High	Controlled access; CCTV; lockdown procedures; staff training
Vandalism or destruction	Damage to property	Medium	Medium	Out of hours security lock-ups; community engagement; insurance
Fire or flooding	Building becomes unsafe	Medium	High	Fire drills; temporary flood barriers
Severe weather	Storms, snow, heatwaves	Medium	Medium	Weather monitoring; heating/cooling systems
Death of pupil or staff	Emotional and operational impact	Low	High	Bereavement & counselling services; communication plan
Epidemic	Widespread illness	Medium	High	Hygiene protocols; remote learning capability; liaison with health authorities
