

The GCSE Geography exam is a universal set of 3 papers, each an hour and 30 minutes long, which examine the topics mentioned above.

### Homework:

Homework is set weekly on SMHW and covers a range of tasks that extend the learning in lessons. Seneca is set regularly to review topics and look back. Additionally, a list of stretch and challenge tasks are set alongside each topic that students can use to reach 'mastery' level in their subject.
