The website contains revision videos, revision materials and exam practice questions for all Science topics.

There are also some licensed revision materials that can be accessed by all Year 11 students on the 'Revision Resource' Google Classroom. Additionally, details of revision guides and workbooks can be found on the Google Classroom.

Exam preparation is about finding the balance between working and rest.

General tips for exam preparation include but are not limited to:

- Get sleep, a rested brain makes it easier to focus.
- Eat well, this will enable better focus and maintain energy levels.
- Stay hydrated, all chemical reactions in the body (even remembering) require an adequate level of hydration.
- Any revision is better than no revision, start today!
- If you haven't got revision notes yet, use resources that have summarised the content already.
- Try a variety of techniques eg: Flash cards, mind maps, diagrams with labels.

Science specific tips are;

- Go over the required practicals, at least one will appear on each paper.
- Remember to go over the 'How Science works' topic.
- Look at past papers and the mark schemes.
